**Distribution of Rice and Dal**

- A. Total No. of five schools i.e., Govt. Upper Primary School, Dameipali, Govt. Upper Primary School, Badauden, Govt. Upper Primary School, Kechubahal, Govt. Primary School, Dunguripali, Govt. Primary School, Lachhimal of Dameipali Gram Panchayat was taken up for analysis of distribution and consumption of food-grains.
- B. As per information supplied by School, total no. of 479 students are enrolled in five schools.
- C. Women SHGs are managing Mid-Day-Meal in 4 schools except Primary Scholl of Kechubahal which is managed by Head Master.
- D. Five months (26th October'08 to 25<sup>th</sup> March'09) was taken up for analysis with regard to distribution and consumption of MDM items in above mentioned five schools..
- E. As per school attendance Register, 56 percent of the children attend the school in every month. But Report submitted by SHGs to Block office says that percentage of attendance in the school in every month is 68.

- F. As per MDM guideline, the Govt. should supply 71.70 quintals of rice to these five schools in 5 months. It is to be mentioned here that 25 days of each month and 125 gram of rice per each student has been taken up for analysis. But as per information supplied by Block, 46.80 quintals of rice has been supplied to these schools. Shortage in supply of rice to schools is 24.90 quintals. The market value of the shortage rice which needs to be supplied to the school is Rs. 37,350.00 ( Rs.15.00 per KG approx.).
- G. Similarly, 1347.50 kg of dal is to be supplied for 479 children of the schools within five months. It is to be mentioned here that 20 gram of dal per day per head has been taken up for analysis. As per secondary information collected from Block, total quantity of 970 kg of dal has been supplied to the schools. A shortage of 377.5 kg is found in supply of dal. Its market value is Rs. 18,850.00 (Rs.50.00 per kg).
- H. It was also found that whatever quantity of rice and dal has been supplied to school, it has been greatly mismanaged by SHGs. For example, out of 46.80 quintals of rice supplied by Block, the children have consumed only 22.07 quintals and 125 gram of rice as per attendance Register. But as per SHG report, 30.08 quintal of rice has been consumed. It means around 8 quintal of rice has been misappropriated by SHGs by reporting false attendance. The market value of misappropriated rice will be Rs. 12,000.00.
- I. In context of supply of dal, it was found that total 970 kg of dal was supplied to schools within five months from Block. As per school attendance Register, 417.610 kg is to be consumed by the children. But SHGs have reported that 548.430 kg of rice has been consumed by children which are found false. SHGs have consumed around 131 kg of dal by reporting false attendance.

- As per Govt. instruction, eggs to be supplied to three schools in 3 months will be 10,176 for total no. of 424 students. But it was found that total quantity of eggs supplied by Block to the schools is 3510. Total quantity of deficit in supply of egg to school is 6684. it's cost will be 16,710.00 ( Rs.2.50 per egg).
- Total quantity of egg supplied by Block within three months is 3510 out of which the students have consumed 2847 as school attendance. Rest of egg balance consumed by SHGs managing MDM is 663. It's cost will be 1657.50.
- In two schools, SHGs have been supplied 2430 egg and as per SHG report, students have consumed 2261 which contradicts the figure as per attendance Register.
- Supply of egg to the schools has been stopped since March'09.
- Now Soya Chunk is being supplied to the schools replacing egg which is tasteless and the students are seen not taking it.

- Fund for other expenses like vegetables, oil, condiments, fuel, supervision charges are not regularly given to the SHGs.
