Sub:- Clarification on the role of Gram Sanjoyaks and Gaon Sathi under MGNREGS.

Ref:- This Department Letter No. 2439 Dated 29.07.2009 and Letter No. 26555 Dated 18-08-2009.

Madam/Sir,

With reference to the letters on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that the Guidelines on the role of Gram Sanjoyaks under MGNREGS was communicated vide this Department Letter No. 2439 Dated 29.07.2009 and subsequently clarification on conflicting role of Gaon Sathis and Gram Sanjoyaks was communicated vide this Department Letter No. 26555 Dated 18-08-2009.

Since some of you have sought certain clarifications on the roles of Gram Sanjoyak and Gaon Sathi, the following points may be taken note of -

1. Every revenue village will have a panel of 7 persons (Gram Sanjoyaks) including 5 numbers of Gram Sanjoyaks and 2 numbers of Gaon Sathis in which Gaon Sathis will be placed in the top of the panel.
2. The work in the village will be entrusted to the members of the panel turn by turn.
3. In each work of a village, 1 Gaon Sathi/Gram Sanjoyak will be engaged as mate. In no case, both Gaon Sathi and Gram Sanjoyak will be engaged as mate in a work.

4. The Gram Sanjoyak will get the wages of a semi skilled labourer per day if he works as a mate in the worksite as per the guidelines. He will be paid wages for such number of days on which the labourers are engaged in the work.
5. If the Gaon Sathi performs the duties of Gram Sanjoyaks in term as per the guidelines on Gram Sanjoyak, he will be paid wages of a semi skilled labourer per day.
6. In no case, a Gaon Sathi can be paid remuneration of Rs.4 per labourer per day as well as wages of a semi skilled labourer.

This is for your information and necessary action.
