As you know, in our capacity as Commissioners of the Supreme Court in CWP 196/2001, PUCL v. UOI and others, we monitor the implementation of the food and work related schemes in the country and regularly submit reports to the Supreme Court.

We would like to take this opportunity to request you for data related to the implementation of food schemes in your State, which we require, to present regular reports for the Supreme Court. Since the affidavits filed by the State Government is invariably just before the deadline, we are often, unable to provide the Supreme Court with the updated information from your Union Territory.

We would appreciate it if the information can be sent in the formats provided in the annexure by 31ST of May.

As you know in its order dated 29.10.2002, the Supreme Court directed each State Government to appoint a Nodal Officer for the purpose of ensuring the due implementation of food-related schemes. Kindly provide us the details including address, phone, fax and email id of the Nodal Officer designated in your state for this purpose. This would greatly facilitate our interface with the Union Territory administration.

We also would like to inform you Mr/Ms _____ is appointed as an adviser in your state to help us with this task. We request you to give him/her all cooperation as has been directed by the Supreme Court.
